## **AGRI 103: Agriculture Economics**

16 weeks, August 21 to December 15  
3 credit hours; Tuition \$339, Fees \$128  
Students explore the agriculture industry and its current issues while learning macroeconomic principles including supply, demand, market structure, competition, international trade and more

## **AGRI 115: Computer Skills in Agriculture**

16 weeks, August 21 to December 15  
3 credit hours; Tuition \$339, Fees \$128  
Students learn to use word-processing, spreadsheet, database, and graphic-presentation software programs in the context of agriculture scenarios

## **HORT 100: Introduction to Horticulture**

3 credit hours; Tuition \$339, Fees \$128  
3 different course sections:  
-16 weeks, August 21 to December 15  
-14 weeks, September 4 to December 15  
- 8 weeks, October 16 to December 8  
Survey of horticultural practices including the selection, use, and care of fruit, vegetable, and ornamental plants. This course is designed to offer the student a general introduction to the principles of plant growth and development as they apply to the wide range of horticultural crops and the industries related to production, marketing and utilization of horticultural crops
